I sold this one to Marla and Jim Nock at the Ocean View Art Show last year sponsored by the Chesapeake Bay Art Association. It was especially wonderful because for several years they have followed me to many shows and always said, "One day were going to buy one of your original paintings." Last year they repeated that, but then said, "This is the day!"
